The Alaska Travel Industry Association (ATIA) is committed to encouraging a policy of local hire within the state's visitor industry. As part of that commitment, ATIA supports efforts that facilitate a well-prepared Alaskan work force.

The ATIA Foundation Scholarship Program was established to assist Alaskan students pursuing the education necessary to help them succeed in the travel and tourism industry.

Scholarships are funded by donations from ATIA members and contributions from ATIA Chapter organizations.

Scholarship recipients will be announced in May.

visitor industry scholarship program offers a number of scholarships worth over \$20,000 in cash and tuition to Alaska students pursuing education related to the tourism industry.

Previous awards included:

- ◇ **ATIA TWO-YEAR SCHOLARSHIP** – A two-year, \$5,000 scholarship with \$2,500 awarded in each of the next two consecutive years.
- ◇ **ATIA ANCHORAGE CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP** – A one-year, \$3,000 scholarship funded through donations raised by the ATIA Anchorage Chapter. A preference will be given to graduating high school seniors.
- ◇ **ATIA CONTINUING EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP** – A one-year, \$2,500 scholarship. Preference will be given to students returning to school for degree or certificate completion or post-graduate study.
- ◇ **ATIA RURAL SCHOLARSHIP** – A one-year, \$2,500 scholarship. Preference will be given to students from rural Alaska, outside of the road network.
- ◇ **KRIS GELDAKER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** – A one-year, \$2,500 scholarship funded through the ATIA Ketchikan Chapter (renewable for up to four years) for students pursuing a degree in tourism or maritime related field. Awards are contingent upon criteria including but not limited to academic performance, stated major, etc., that are determined by statewide and Ketchikan scholarship committees. Preference will be given to applicants intending to work in Alaska or are a son/daughter of someone presently working in the tourism industry.
- ◇ **ALASKA TRAVEL ADVENTURES SCHOLARSHIP** – A one-year, \$1,000 scholarship funded by Alaska Travel Adventures.
- ◇ **CHUCK WEST MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** – A one-year, \$1,000 scholarship funded through an endowment in memory of Chuck West.
- ◇ **PRINCESS CRUISES & TOURS SCHOLARSHIP** – A one-year, \$1,000 scholarship funded by Princess Cruises & Tours.
- ◇ **ATIA ONE-YEAR SCHOLARSHIP** – A one-year, \$1,000 scholarship funded through member pledges.
- ◇ **ATIA CONTINUING EDUCATION AWARD** – A one-year, \$1,000 award for adult students pursuing tourism-related studies or professional certification.

GENERAL APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

Students interested in the tourism industry who meet the following general criteria may apply for an ATIA Foundation scholarship.

- ◇ Is enrolled or intending to enroll on a full-time basis (or part-time for the ATIA Graduate or Continuing Education Scholarship) in a program of study in preparation for a career in tourism.

(Examples have included, but are not limited to: the Hotel & Tourism Management program offered at Alaska Pacific University; the Culinary Arts and Hospitality/ Restaurant Management programs offered at the University of Alaska Anchorage; vocational-technical courses offered at schools such as the Career Academy, Alaska Travel Concepts and Seward Avtec; and other degree programs, such as business or marketing, with the intent to pursue a career in travel and tourism.)

- ◇ Is an Alaska resident.

SELECTION CRITERIA CONSIDERED

The ATIA Foundation uses a number of criteria to judge applications, including financial need, demonstrated tourism initiative, grade point average in previous studies, and whether the educational institution is located in Alaska.

HOW TO APPLY FOR AN ATIA SCHOLARSHIP

Students applying for scholarships must complete the attached ATIA scholarship application form. Forms are also available from the ATIA office or at www.AlaskaTIA.org. Completed applications must be submitted to ATIA along with:

- ◇ One copy of your high school or college transcripts
- ◇ A one-page statement of your tourism career plans
- ◇ Two letters of recommendation, dated within one year

Applications and attachments must reach the ATIA office by March 19, 2010.

Note: The attached application is valid for all scholarships. It is not necessary to indicate which scholarship you are applying for - scholarship awards will be determined by the ATIA Scholarship Committee.
