- **Juniors and Seniors may enroll in a MyHigh course without the need for a specific reason. Sophomores may enroll with counselor recommendation and approval with specific reason (schedule conflict, course not offered at school site, etc.) For each student, the counselor's signature on the application indicates the counselor has met with the student to:**
 - *make certain the student has access to a computer with high speed internet access at home*
 - *demonstrates the academic skills, motivation, and commitment needed to successfully complete an online course*
 - *determine if the student has an IEP or 504 Plan, marked this on the form if needed, and attached a copy of the accommodations page of the IEP or 504 with the application.*
