Setting

Ashland, Oregon is located in the southwest corner of the state, next to Northern California. It is home to Southern Oregon University. The plan is to stay on campus in one of their conference halls.

The planned dates for the trip are May 13th (Monday) to May 17th (Friday). This is the 2nd week of the Intensive.

Now, to the Heart of the Matter

The number one question so far has been, "how much is the trip going to cost?" Here is the breakdown so far (est. 18 students):

3 plays = \$63.5; 4 plays = \$84.5

Rooms = \$108 for three nights, \$144 for four nights

Meals (negotiable) = \$105 for 4 days, 3 meals a day (SOU cafeteria)

Workshop = \$5.50; Exploring Design = \$5; Prologues = \$3.50

Airline Ticket, Round Trip = \$815

Total Price per student = \$1105.50 – \$1162.50
