### **Parent Group Committee Reports**

### Principal:

Dale - Not much movement at this stage of the semester. RTI scores at this time show an upward trend from one test to another. Talent show auditions at noon on 1/24 and after school. Not a competition! All Community Meeting on 17<sup>th</sup> of this month. Parent group volunteers needed. Some awards given at last meeting. Molly Rardin won Lions Club award. Certificate given to Ben Curtiss for a Commendable Mention for National Merit Scholarship. Tate Miles and Bob Miller also acknowledged for their efforts during their trip to China. Karen Glavinic worked on developing Website, even after children left Steller. Developed and succumbed to cancer. Forthcoming Raffle to help with remaining medical burden.

Staff:

Philip - Moving end of 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter to end of first week before spring break; March 1<sup>st</sup>, to even out quarter lengths. All community meeting volunteers needed; All Community meeting plan: introduction, follow up on 1<sup>st</sup> All Community meeting, then break out into session. Thursday January 17<sup>th</sup> from 6;30 - 8:30 p.m.

Ad Board: Cancelled

Op Group: No report; meets tomorrow.

### **New Business:**

- Souper Steller taking place this Friday.
- Treasurer leaving position; Rebecca willing to do checks but need person to take over; Ken Norris is not able to take over. Denali has an accountant, an option but would prefer having someone who is a Steller parent and CPA volunteer for the position. Colleen Bickford contact suggestion: interns at UAA that may be an option as a short term solution. Perhaps a business partner is an option.

Rebecca - Time commitment 90 hours / year (auction, budget, credit card processing, 3-5 hour for registration; phone contact time; time has been tracked by Rebecca for reference. A 2 person position would be a good idea because of all the data entry. Perhaps Treasurer for signatures and a CPA book keeper to run credit cards and accounting. Generally runs ~\$85 / hour; may be cheaper to have an accountant. Working to have reimbursements for auction done soon. Thinks there are enough funds for Souper Steller to run the rest of the year and part of first semester next year. Also, CES fund processing is every other year; t-shirts and talent show proceeds contribute so there is time to fundraise for this conference. Rochelle puts cash directly into t-shirt sales; parent group funded and was paid back (took 2 years). CES = Coalition of Essential Schools. This year the cost for sending 2 teachers and 2 students was around \$5K.

Discussion of funds; Rebecca J. suggests better communication to use money. The auction has occurred and now we need to solicit suggestions and decide on how to use what has been accrued. Auction traditionally funds yearbook, travel scholarships, CES. Additionally, Parent Group funds other activities. We need to have an ability to say "this is where your donations have gone and what you have supported".

#### Run of numbers:

Auction (rough total) \$15,000 - \$4050 (Souper Steller)= \$10,950

Parent Group project = \$3700 (\$2765 + \$945)

\$ to Ad Board from 2011-2012 = \$4,500

Cushion of operating emergency funds = \$1,800

Yearbook is well funded

**Travel Scholarships** done for this school year; 4,500 to start, not much left. \$2500-3500 contribution by Parent Group

### CES has little to no funds.

Souper Steller well funded currently; propose keeping as auction item for future funding

**Technology** upcoming needs: \$1600 for iPod Zags to go with the staff iPods (already funded).

We cannot donate more than \$4999 / year directly to Steller. If more than \$500 - 800 (can be funded by Special Projects) needed, a designation can be made and funds held for use.

Wendy - What kind of things do we feel is important to spend money on? How do we designate / spend this money? We feel it is important to fund the travel scholarships and CES, perhaps other amounts can be pooled and drawn from as requested.

Philip - Originally 80% of Auction was set for Travel, given to Parent group 3 years ago.

Dale recommends no more than \$2500 for CES; it is for 2 students and 2 teachers, and used every 2 years. Discussion about scholarships, and contribution of time by student with scholarship.
