We will take part in science programs they offer, as well as spending an hour of our free time preparing science kits for younger students. We will leave Steller at 2pm on Wednesday, August 19th and return to Steller by 12:30pm on Thursday, August 20th. We will travel by car, and are in need of parent volunteers.

The cost of the field trip is \$30. This amount includes dinner on the 19th and breakfast on the 20th, as well as the cost of the science program and the cost of staying the night at the SeaLife Center. Students' costs were offset by a generous grant from Parent Group. Payments need to be made to Janet in the front office by the end of this school year. Students are responsible for bringing snacks; they will not have an opportunity to buy other food while on the trip. Students will need to pack a sleeping bag, overnight clothes and toiletries, and appropriate outdoor clothes for the weather. A detailed packing list will be forthcoming. Students will be chaperoned by teachers and parents for the entire duration of the trip.
