Troy plans to use the ice rink for a class as well and a skating club may be established; both Troy and the club could also take advantage of the skates.

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Discussion. Could the skates be stored in a tub or somewhere accessible for PE classes and available for check-out by students at lunch time or after school. Question regarding liability. ASD is self-insured though helmets should be worn for all games and activities. Consider a future purchase of helmets. There is potential for an after school speed skating course.

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Legislative Grant. Changes to the legislative grants are due December 10. Reed is working to maintain the \$27K intended for a rock wall. Staff requests additional Chromebooks at \$325 each for interactive class activities. Reed is looking for other ideas. Considering extending the WiFi capabilities to allow for more connections per classroom. Bandwidth is currently the bottleneck.

Common Application. Recommended for seniors. There is a learning curve, but more universities are using this digital centralized application. Components include student information, school provided information, and teacher recommendations.
