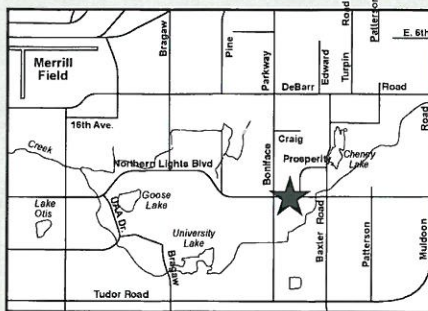

One-stop enrollment for new-to-district families and students

The Anchorage School District is offering central enrollment and registration opportunities for certain families. At this event, parents will be able to enroll their children at one location and speak with ASD department representatives to assist them in areas such as assessment, nursing services, immunizations, counseling, community services, before- and after-school care and more. While this can also be done at each school site, central enrollment is available Friday evening and Saturday.

Central enrollment is for:

New-to-district families who aren't able to attend regular registration at their child's school

- Elementary, middle and high school students who are new to ASD
- Kindergarten students need to register at their school during registration week

Returning families who are:

- New-to-ASD English Language Learners
- Military
- Child in Transition
- Migrant
- Special Education
- Families requiring additional support

To complete enrollment, parents must bring:

- Birth certificate
- Proof of residency, such as a utility or phone bill, contract of purchase or lease agreement
- Transcript (for middle and high school students only)
- Current official record of immunization
 - Diphtheria, pertussis and tetanus
 - Polio
 - Measles, mumps and rubella
 - Hepatitis A
 - Hepatitis B
 - Varicella (two doses are required for grades K-6)
- Bring your children that you are registering
