- Grade point average of at least 3.0
- Student must be accepted as a full-time student by either a business, trade or college institution

## The AFFA Scholarship Review Committee selects the winners based on the following scoring points:

30 points - Academic Achievement/GPA

20 points - Essay

20 points - AFFA participation (Volunteering in AFFA activites)

20 points - Student Leadership and/or Extracurricular Activities (ex: Student Government,

Orchestra, ROTC, etc.)

10 points - Community Service (ex: Citywide Clean-up)

NOTE: Preference will be given to children of current AFFA members.
