Principal Report.

Reed reporting.

ASD Budget. Governor Walker proposed a flat state budget, the same as last year. One proposal for the school board includes cutting 17 full-time positions from alternative schools, which equals 1.5 to 3 positions at Steller. Overall, the state per pupil ratio will go down though the money will as well. 89% of the budget is people.

Unlikely that the legislature will go above the Governor's proposed budget. Opportunity for the Steller community to reach out and support and join coalitions like Great Alaska Schools. Superintendent prefers more small schools.

Pat would like a small group of parents to work with Reed and prepare to defend the Steller budget while working alongside parents from other schools. Shannon will lead this effort. Alyse and Leslie volunteer. Looking for more volunteers. Anyone interested should contact Shannon.

Self-Directed Learning. The staff still wishes to move towards a self-directed learning program and hopes to present their ideas to the Steller community soon.

Recruitment. Radio adverts similar to last year will be run again this year, beginning earlier. Schools visits are occurring this week with Steller students visiting their own elementary schools and talking about the benefits of attending Steller. Today was the first Tuesday for February school tours and Steller was visited by 4-5 families. Steller flyer has been distributed to elementary schools across the district.

Peak. New school performance testing. Scheduled for April. Proposed schedule is approximately 90-minute blocks for 7th and 8th graders and approximately 3-hour blocks for 9th and 10th grade students. Blocks are broken into two week sessions per group. Reed, Marianne, and Simone will be covering testing.
